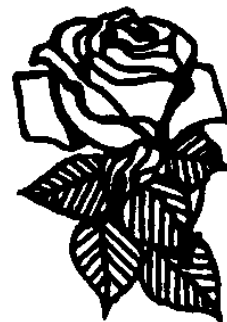

George Rose of England and New York: U.S. ARMY

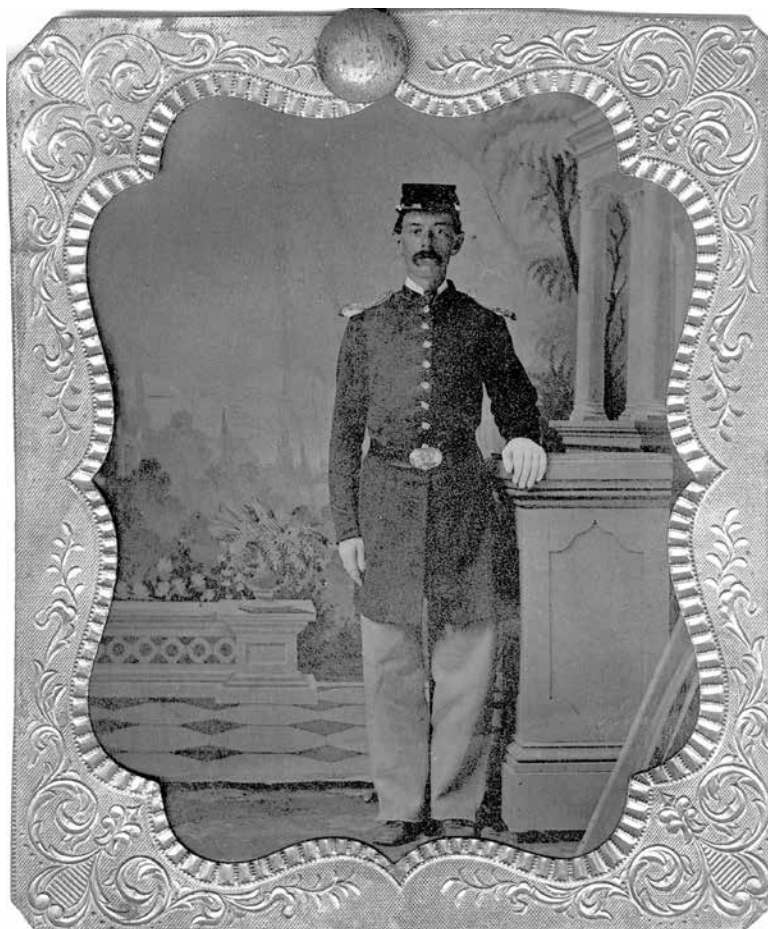
This was copied by editor from National Archives Record Group 15. The file is cited as GEORGE ROSE. Co. B 16 and Co. B 34 U.S. Inf. invalid filed 1906, application #1348113, applied from England.

Affidavit: Kent Co., England 2 Apr. 1906, George Rose, resident of 15 Egmont St., New Cross, London S.C., Co. Surrey, England, enrolled at Buffalo, 5 or 6 Jan. 1862, Priv. Co. B 1st Battn. 16 U.S. Inf., discharged 5 or 6 Jan. 1865, b. 14 June 1840 at St. Georges, Southwark, London, England S.E., 5' 7 1/2", fair compl., black hair, hazel eyes, etc. Signed name.

Letter: 18 Nov. 1907, refers to brother Thomas Rose of 900 Centre St., Syracuse, N.Y., Thomas is 10 years younger, mentions a brother Edwin who is 5 years younger, brother [Thomas] died at Christmas, I was first of thirteen children, only four of us left.

Letter: Feb. 24, 1908, 15 Egmont St., New Cross, London S.C., England, letter mentions letter sent to brother Thomas Rose [by Commissioner of Pensions], and gives his reply. Signed: George Rose.

Letter dated March 27, 1908, from the Army & Navy Division, I.O. 1348113, George Rose, B, 3d Battn., 16th U.S. Inf., Act June 27, 1890, addressed to Mr. George Rose, #15 Egmont St., New Cross, London, England. "Sir: Your above-cited claim for pension is rejected on the ground of no title under the act of June 27, 1890, for the reason that your service in Co. B, 3d Battn., 16th U. S. Inf., and in Co. B, 34th U.S. Inf., was rendered subsequent to the close of the Rebellion, as shown by the records of the War Department. Very respectfully, Commissioner." This letter was sent in response to a letter written by George Rose March 5, 1907 from the above address stating that he is convinced his information in previous affidavits is correct, etc. His last words were "kindly send Photo Back" though it still resides in the file at the National Archives.



It is clear that the problem with this claim lie not in whether George Rose had military service, but in the fact that his service was not during the Civil War, as he claimed in his affidavits, but in the U. S. Army immediately *after* the Civil War. (In one letter the Commissioner wrote to George's brother Thomas Rose, and inferred that George had some problems with his mental faculties which infuriated this claimant!)

Dear Readers,

Those interested in the Rose collection donated from the Rose Family Association to the New England Historic Genealogical Society in Boston can refer to MS1182 of their collections. The collection is maintained offsite so inquire to them before your visit to ascertain if there is a waiting period. If you find yourself in Massachusetts do visit there not only for Rose but for other of your families. They have an immense collection!



We continue to hear from many others who are new to the Rose search, or who have worked for years alone on their search and now have discovered the immense Rose collection. It is amazing how many people have Rose lines! The family is "unusual" in that it does not trace back to one immigrant as many families do. Instead, there are many early Rose immigrants, sometimes from the same country but unrelated to each other.

Many of you are experienced Internet users and have found on your own the many available websites - some free and some with subscription fees - devoted to genealogy. Among them ancestry.com, fold3.com, americanancestors.org, familysearch.org, and a host of others. But, in spite of this, there is no website that provides the early courthouse records of the United States. Sometimes a particular website will include some images from their own county but these are few. Those searching for records in courthouses have two options: visit the courthouse personally, or use microfilm of the LDS. The microfilm is a great asset but we must remember that when the filming was done not all of the records in the courthouse were filmed. Just the main records - deeds, probates, vital records and some others, usually up to the late 1800s. Those courthouses often have unfiled original court records, isolated books of bonds, licenses, etc. just to name a few. Nothing is a substitute for a personal visit.

SPECIAL: Those not familiar with courthouse research should read a copy of Christine Rose's *Courthouse Research for Family Historians: Your Guide to Genealogical Treasures*. This will take you from the beginning - preparation, how to approach the clerk, what to look for, what to look for in each department and much more. This book, 219, xviii pages, 8 1/2 x 11, is fully illustrated and indexed. Available normally for \$21.98 plus \$6.45 shipping, it is being offered to Rose Family Association members as a special for \$15.00 plus \$6.45 postage until August 1, 2015. Frederick Rose of Hardin and Wayne Counties, Tennessee Descendants of Big Flat, Baxter County, Arkansas



Above photos by Don Ott many years ago. The town is Big Flat, Arkansas where a number of descendants of the Frederick Rose family of Tennessee settled. Frederick⁵ Rose was originally of Sussex County, Virginia and later of Orange County, North Carolina. This family is a part of Group A-1 of the YDNA project.

The tombstone, difficult to read above, shows Nancy E. Rose, wife of J. H. Rose, born Aug. 17, 1861, died Apr. 10, 1900. It is presumed that they are members of the Frederick Rose family. Does anyone identify them?

Caleb Hitchcock⁵ Rose (Jacob⁴, Robert³, Tychicus², Robert¹), was born 25 May 1844 on the Rose Farm, near Deavertown, York twp., Morgan County, Ohio. He died 13 April 1898 and is buried in the Ashland Cemetery in Ashland, Saunders County, Nebraska. He married 27 or 30 April 1865 to Margaret Jane Adamsom. She was born 2 August 1844 in Roseville, Muskingum County, Ohio, and died 19 August 1924, Boise, Ada County, Idaho, and is buried with her husband. She was the daughter of Rev. Vincent Cemetery, Osborne County, Kansas

(4 MI. N OF LURAY ON US 281 AND 1 1/2 MI. WEST)

Submitted by the late Kenneth E. Rose, Lawrence County, Kansas in 1988.

The Rose family marker is at the center of six smaller rectangular stones inscribed as follows: Front row, l. to r. (1) Mother, Marie A., 1847-1931 (2) Father, Augustus, Co. K, 4th Minn. Vol., 1838-1904 (3) Grandfather, John W. 1801-1882.* Back row, l. to r. (4) Sister, Mae, 1872-1950 (5) Brother, Abe, 1883-1949 (6) Uncle, Co-



rydon, 1835-1908. The columnar stone in the forefront appears to be on a plot immediately in front of the markers for Mark and Mattie Rose. Engraving on the pedestal is almost illegible, but seems to be limited to name ROSE. The three small markers read, l. to r., (1) Infant, died Jan. 28, 1907, (2) Infant, died Dec. 3, 1899, and (3) Infant, died Dec. 22, 1900. There is no further indication of the parents.

*John W(hite) Rose was the son of John and Sarah (White) Rose of Jefferson County, New York. He married Mary E. Larkin and had Corydon, Dell, Augustus, Mary and perhaps others. They lived in 1850 St. Lawrence County, New York.

Henry Thomas Rose and Jane (Mahoney/Mahorney) Rose of King George & Stafford Counties, Virginia



Eliza Gordon Rose was born 8 September 1857 in Stafford County, Virginia. She was the daughter of Thomas Henry and Susan Ann (Shelton) Rose. Eliza died 7 August 1933 in Richmond, Virginia. She married 13 June 1881 in Stafford County to James Edward Armstrong who was born 27 April 1859 in Stafford County. They were members of the First Baptist Church. Several of their family members are shown in the photograph to the left including member Virginia Gordon Hearn.

Identification by member Virginia Hearn Whiting: Uncle Ashton Armstrong, Aunt Eunice Armstrong, cousin James Curtis, Aunt Lola Armstrong Curtis and Grandad James E. Armstrong. Henry² Rose (John¹) was born ca 1784-1794 (1810 census), died either 1 January 1816 [sic, 1818] (War of 1812 Land Bounty file) or 1818 (War of 1812 pension file), or "middle of January" 1818 (another affidavit in war files), King George County, Virginia (Ibid.).

Henry married, license 6 December 1813, King George County, Virginia (Land Bounty file, by Parson Davis, a Baptist Minister), Jane Mahoney (shown sometimes as Mahorney), born ca 1795-1797. [One affidavit by her sister indicates they were married 1815-1816, and an affidavit years later in her pension file states that they were married "about 1810."] She was living at age 84 in 1872 in Stafford County, Virginia. She died 18 February 1873 (pension file).

Henry Rose served in the War of 1812. His land bounty file (#55-160 WT 69248, National Archives) shows he was private under Capt. Samuel Davis, Col. Austin Smith, Virginia Militia. His widow Jane Rose made affidavit from Stafford County, Virginia 6 August 1855 stating her age as 60, resident of said county, that he volunteered at King George County 25 August (year not given) for the War, that she married him (no date given) by Jesse Davis, a Baptist Preacher, that her name before marriage was Jane Mahoney, and that he died in King George 1 January 1816. She signed it by an x mark, and it was witnessed by John (his x mark) Boutyard and Thomas Rose. On 21 March 1857 she made an affidavit, aged "70-000" years, same county, and states that he died 1 January (year not given). This was witnessed by Elijah Grover and Albert Blonton. Again, the marriage date was left blank. On 7 March 1857 William Humphries made oath regarding the war service, and states he knew him well before they entered the Service, "lived about half mile apart" and he remained at the same place for about two or three years after they were discharged. He further states that he received a Land Warrant number not recollected which he disposed of. On 28 May 1857 Sarah Butcher and William Humphries appeared and made affidavit that they were well acquainted with Jane Rose; Humphries says he lived within one fourth or half mile, was present at the wedding, that Henry Rose died in King George County "some time about the middle of January 1816 and helped to bury him in King George County. Sarah Butcher states she is sister of Jane Rose, that they married sometime in the year 1815 or 16 in King George, that she was not at the marriage though she saw them soon after, they were married at a neighbours home nearby. She states that Henry Rose died in King George County sometime "between the years 1816 & 19" and that she had moved to Stafford but they sent her word. She signed it Sarah "bouteyard." Thomas Rose made an affidavit in Stafford County 21 March 1857 that he was well acquainted with Jane Rose, widow of Henry Rose, deceased, but does not specify his relationship. He signed it Thos. 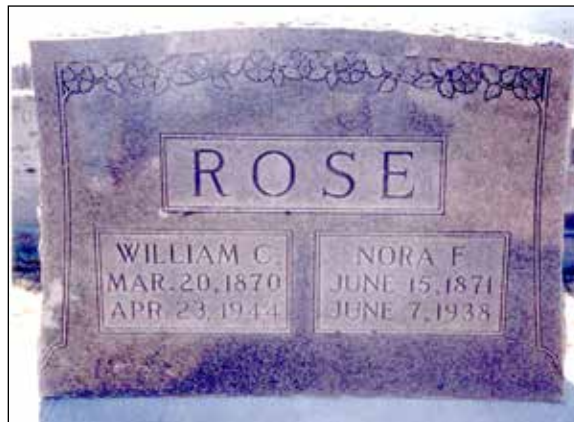

New York 1827 Divorce

In a divorce action between William Rose and his wife, in which she sued for divorce because of his adultery, the divorce was granted. What is especially interesting was the clause "And it shall be lawful for the said [wife's name] to marry again as though the said William Rose was actually dead, but it shall not be lawful for the said William Rose to marry again until the said [wife's name] shall be actually dead. [Editor was told by a New York attorney that the divorce laws of New York stood in this manner until mid-1900s! Also interesting was the condition that the living descendant who requested a copy of these court papers had to go before a Judge in New York and prove his descent. When the Judge granted his request for a copy, the adulteress' name was redacted.]

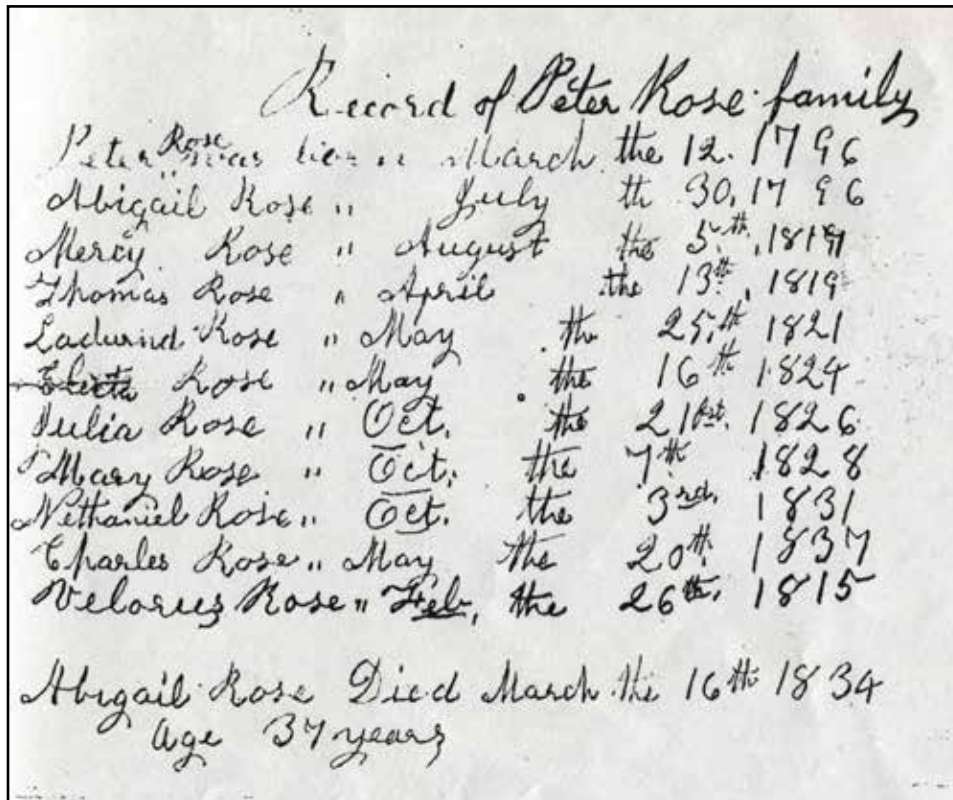

The family is said to have come originally from Connecticut. During the Revolution, the family of Lauren Rose's grandfather (name unknown) was captured during an Indian massacre. The father was tortured and killed, reportedly, burned at the stake. The mother and three children who were taken into captivity later made their escape and reached one of the settlements. Timothy Rose was a baby in his mother's arms at the time this event took place, says the family tradition.

Timothy Rose moved from Catskill, New York to the western part of the state. Among his children was a son Nelson Rose who died probably before 8 November 1841 (estate). He married on 1 December 1836, Tippecanoe County, Indiana VR, to Esther Ann Johnson. The latter had a son Newton Holmes³ Rose born ca 1838. He died 1902, Arroyo Grande, California and is buried there in the Arroyo Grande District Cemetery. Newton married in San Luis Obispo County, California, to Hannah Melvina (Beckett) Cocke. She was born 27 October 1852, in Oregon, and died 8 September 1923, Glendale, California., buried there in the in the Grandview Memorial.

Newton Rose lived in 1864 in Santa Cruz County, California, evidenced by a Deed Bk 45 pp 531-532, Newton H. The appearance of Alice Rose with him on this deed suggests strongly that he is indeed the son of William and Alice () Rose of King George county, Virginia, and that Alice is his mother. However, more proof is needed. It should be noted that Alice can be show as Eles in some records.

Son of Thomas Rose of Pope County, Illinois

Bluford Rose was the son of Thomas and Ann (Bronner) Rose of Pope County, Illinois and Franklin County, Georgia. YDNA testing puts this family in Group F which includes Henry Rose of Pope County, Thomas Rose of Vanderburg County, Indiana and others. Bluford married 1st 1 June 1848 in Pope County to Malvina Sutherland. He married 2nd 30 March 1859 to Ann Malisa () Hays, and was divorced from her as above stating that she left him in November 1859. Bluford married third 18 March 1862 to Nancy Jane Bramlet/ Bramblet. One of the children of his first marriage. (Rev.) James Buchanan Rose, moved to California and later died in Santa Clara County where he and his second wife are buried in the Oak Hill Cemetery in San Jose. One was the listing for a book, *Stalin's Man in Canada: Fred Rose and Soviet Espionage* by David Levy. Fred Rose was a labor organizer, left wing politician, Soviet agent and Atomic spy. This book is available from Enigma Books.

Also from Joan was a feature article in the *Centralia Sentinel* of Sunday Nov. 2, 2014 on "The state's oldest inn, the Rose Hotel in Elizabethtown, sits on the banks of the Ohio River. This lengthy piece by Judith John, Sentinel Feature Editor, states that the hotel "is said to be the oldest hotel in the state." It is accompanied by several photos. We have published past articles - it was owned for some time by widow Sarah Rose wife of Wiley³ Rose (Wiley², Henry¹)
