

In Memoriam: David Wadsworth Brown, born October 4, 1949, died November 1, 2011, at Surrey Memorial Hospital in Canada. David was the force behind our extensive Rose Y-DNA project. He was among the pioneers in the use of Y-DNA for genealogy, and during the years became an expert in interpreting the tests. David always was available to help testees in interpreting their tests, and in finding links in their Rose families. He was friendly to all, knowledgeable, and full of humor. David was seriously ill for several months before he passed on, but always thinking of the DNA project, he picked Marcia Brown (no relationship to David) as his replacement and trained her. The project continues under her able leadership, but we all will miss David tremendously. *While Christine was lecturing a few weeks ago at the Fox Valley Genealogical Society in Naperville, Illinois, she bought at a book sale there a copy of Laws of the State of Illinois enacted by the Forty-second General Assembly (Springfield, Ill.: Phillips Bros., State Printers, 1901). The cover is marked and a note written on it "Placed Public Lib. 1901]. It also has notes on the spine, and a sticker on the spine and another sticker on the inside of the front cover. However, what should interest a Rose descendant is that inside there is a handwritten note "Compliments of James A. Rose, Sec'y of State." This is James Alexander³ Rose (John Drury², Thomas¹) was born 13 October 1850 and died 29 May 1912 (*Ibid.*), Springfield, Sangamon County, Illinois, and is buried in Golconda, Pope County, Illinois. He married, 14 July 1874, Elizabeth Michie Young who was born 14 July 1850, Aberdeen, Scotland. She died 7 December 1933 and is buried with her husband. The grandfather Thomas Rose married Ann Bronner and came out of Georgia. This family matches Group F of the Rose DNA project, Roses of the Granville County, North Carolina area. 

held Feb. 14 [year not shown]. Interment in Sand Creek cemetery. She died just 22 years to a day after the burial of her husband. She was born in Moultrie County, Illinois, Oct. 17, 1853, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. K. Baker. In 1872 she married James K. P. Rose who died Feb. 10, 1914. Eight children were born, all living: Clarabelle Wilson of Champaign, Iva B. Guin of Findlay, Mrs. C. D. Baker of Windsor, Carter of St. Louis, Wilbur W. of Decatur, Henry, Kenny and Lucinda at home. William H. Rose departed this life May 1 at his home in Windsor twp. He was a son of John Rose, deceased, and was born in Shelby County July 11, 1841, thus being almost 81 years old. In September 1860 he married Mary J. Wilson. Five children were born; the wife and three children preceeded him into death. He leaves a son James P. of Louisiana, Mo., a daughter Anna. Signed: W--? Ruschenberg, M.D., Surgeon.

Pension granted March 9, 1838. Certificate issued same date. [He requested admission to Naval Asylum of Philadelphia.]



[No. 10.] A Resolution authorizing suitable Acknowledgments to be made by the President, to the British Naval Authorities at Jamaica, for the Relief extended to the Officers and Crew of the United States Ship "Susquehannah," disabled by Yellow Fever.

May 11, 1868.
Aste, p. 325.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the President be, and he is hereby, authorized and requested to cause suitable acknowledgments to be made on the part of this Government to Admiral Sir Howston Stewart, of her Britannic Majesty's Navy, and the officers under his command, for their prompt and efficient aid, and generous hospitality, extended to the disabled officers and crew of the United States ship "Susquehannah," on her late arrival at Port Royal, in the Island of Jamaica, with the yellow fever on board; on which occasion, besides placing the naval hospital, with an adequate corps of medical officers, nurses, and attendants, at their service, eighty-five of the sick officers and crew of the "Susquehannah" were safely and promptly conveyed on shore with the aid of the boats of the British squadron, and the lives of the greater portion of them thereby probably saved. And that the President be further requested to cause a gold medal, with appropriate devices, to be presented, on behalf of this Government, to Assistant-Surgeon Frederick A. Rose, of the British navy, who volunteered, with the permission of his commanding officer, to join the "Susquehannah," and, at imminent personal risk, devoted himself, on the voyage from Jamaica to New York, to the care of the sick remaining on board. And that the President cause suitable testimonials to be in like manner presented to the medical officers, in the British service, in attend-






Garland Preston Rose Sr.

GUIDE TO READING THIS TABLE

Since the beginning of our Rose Project in 2001, we have seen the markers available to be tested progressively grow from the original 12, now to 111. Each step forward has been a refinement, providing a better confidence level in results, and often allowing us to define certain lines or subgroups within larger original Rose families. Due to space limitations and readability, we now provide 37 in this table, although all conclusions made are on the basis of all markers tested. We sincerely hope this provides you with more information and a better perspective of the results.

This table is divided into family groups which are indicated to be paternally related by their Y-DNA results thus far. Each group is identified by a 1-3 character Alpha-Numeric symbol. These include Groups A to Z, AA to NN, AL, CX, and others. All participants within each Group are estimated to share a common All-Male Line Ancestor at a Genealogical time frame, or since the surname may have become meaningful. In the Identification each group, when a numeral follows a letter, it identifies either a specific branch (Subgroup) within the same family (see K1, T2), or a Group estimated to be related further back in time, usually before Emigration (see A1, K2, L1). When an X or Y follows a letter, it indicates a Non-Paternal relationship with the above group, which is noted in the title line. No other relationships in a meaningful time frame appear likely between the separate groups. Kit numbers which appear in **bold** indicate new results since the last printing.

The column on the far right, labeled "PROB%", indicates the statistical probability (confidence level) that this sample belongs to their respective family group or subgroup. The sample within each group estimated to be most representative of the original pattern appears in **bold** print. All others in the group are measured against his results.

The DYS # refer to specific locations within the Y-Chromosome. The numeric value under each is the number of Short Tandem Repeats in the sample at that location. These STR's are repeated nucleotide sequences, or spacing, as on a ladder, which the DNA physically resembles. Variations in these numbers (**shown in bold italics**) are the result of mutations occurring between samples and can often be indicative of the distance of the relationship, or in extremes, an independent family Group. However the specific markers (Loci) involved, and other factors must be taken into consideration. Many markers mutate much faster than others. Great advances have been made in the study of those markers and their individual characteristics in recent years. These allow us to interpret the results
