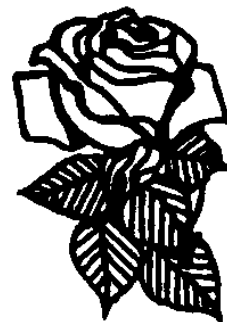

In Memoriam: David Wadsworth Brown, born October 4, 1949, died November 1, 2011, at Surrey Memorial Hospital in Canada. David was the force behind our extensive Rose Y-DNA project. He was among the pioneers in the use of Y-DNA for genealogy, and during the years became an expert in interpreting the tests. David always was available to help testees in interpreting their tests, and in finding links in their Rose families. He was friendly to all, knowledgeable, and full of humor. David was seriously ill for several months before he passed on, but always thinking of the DNA project, he picked Marcia Brown (no relationship to David) as his replacement and trained her. The project continues under her able leadership, but we all will miss David tremendously. While Christine was lecturing a few weeks ago at the Fox Valley Genealogical Society in Naperville, Illinois, she bought at a book sale there a copy of Laws of the State of Illinois enacted by the Forty-second General Assembly (Springfield, Ill.: Phillips Bros., State Printers, 1901). The cover is marked and a note written on it "Placed Public Lib. 1901]. It also has notes on the spine, and a sticker on the spine and another sticker on the inside of the front cover. However, what should interest a Rose descendant is that inside there is a handwritten note "Compliments of James A. Rose, Sec'ty of State." This is James Alexander³ Rose (John Drury², Thomas¹) was born 13 October 1850 and died 29 May 1912 (Ibid.), Springfield, Sangamon County, Illinois, and is buried in Golconda, Pope County, Illinois. He married, 14 July 1874, Elizabeth Michie Young who was born 14 July 1850, Aberdeen, Scotland. She died 7 December 1933 and is buried with her husband. The grandfather Thomas Rose married Ann Bronner and came out of Georgia. This family matches Group F of the Rose DNA project, Roses of the Granville County, North Carolina area. 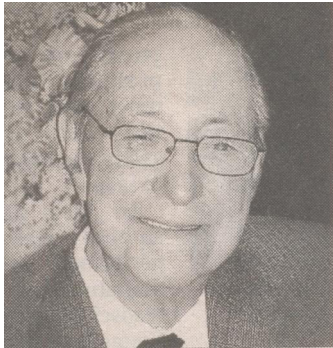

held Feb. 14 [year not shown]. Interment in Sand Creek cemetery. She died just 22 years to a day after the burial of her husband. She was born in Moultrie County, Illinois, Oct. 17, 1853, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. K. Baker. In 1872 she married James K. P. Rose who died Feb. 10, 1914. Eight children were born, all living: Clarabelle Wilson of Champaign, Iva B. Guin of Findlay, Mrs. C. D. Baker of Windsor, Carter of St. Louis, Wilbur W. of Decatur, Henry, Kenny and Lucinda at home. William H. Rose departed this life May 1 at his home in Windsor twp. He was a son of John Rose, deceased, and was born in Shelby County July 11, 1841, thus being almost 81 years old. In September 1860 he married Mary J. Wilson. Five children were born; the wife and three children preceded him into death. He leaves a son James P. of Louisiana, Mo., a daughter Anna. 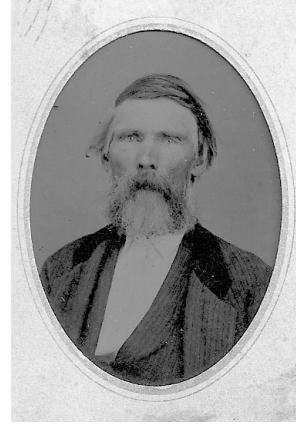

[No. 10.] *A Resolution authorizing suitable Acknowledgments to be made by the President, to the British Naval Authorities at Jamaica, for the Relief extended to the Officers and Crew of the United States Ship "Susquehannah," disabled by Yellow Fever.*

May 11, 1858.

Auto, p. 325.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the President be, and he is hereby, authorized and requested to cause suitable acknowledgments to be made on the part of this Government to Admiral Sir Howston Stewart, of her Britannic Majesty's Navy, and the officers under his command, for their prompt and efficient aid, and generous hospitality, extended to the disabled officers and crew of the United States ship "Susquehannah," on her late arrival at Port Royal, in the Island of Jamaica, with the yellow fever on board; on which occasion, besides placing the naval hospital, with an adequate corps of medical officers, nurses, and attendants, at their service, eighty-five of the sick officers and crew of the "Susquehannah" were safely and promptly conveyed on shore with the aid of the boats of the British squadron, and the lives of the greater portion of them thereby probably saved. And that the President be further requested to cause a gold medal, with appropriate devices, to be presented, on behalf of this Government, to Assistant-Surgeon Frederick A. Rose, of the British navy, who volunteered, with the permission of his commanding officer, to join the "Susquehannah," and, at imminent personal risk, devoted himself, on the voyage from Jamaica to New York, to the care of the sick remaining on board. And that the President cause suitable testimonials to be in like manner presented to the medical officers, in the British service, in attend-

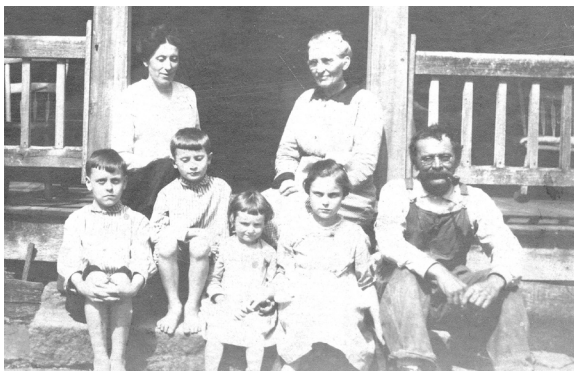

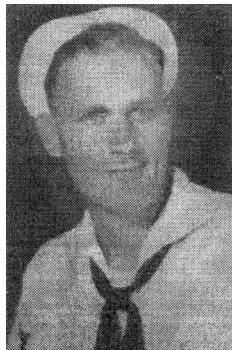

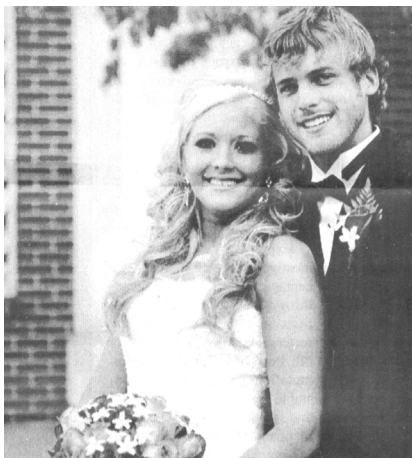
In Memoriam
