

The above Daniel⁴ Rose (Jonathan³, Daniel², Robert¹) was born 12 January 1716/7 in Durham, Connecticut, and died in 1790 in Granville, Massachusetts. He married Achsah "Accy" Ball. Information on this family appears in Christine Rose, Descendants of Robert Rose of Branford and Wethersfield, Connecticut Who Came on the Ship Francis from Ipswich, England in 1634 (San Jose, Calif.: Braun-Brumfield, 1983),, pages 40-43 and 74-75.

The above book is still available from the Rose Family Association. This New England family is the largest of all of the Rose families in the United States, with many descendants. We are seeking DNA tests from Suffolk County, England, in the hope of finding one that matches the U.S. family so that descendants on both sides of the ocean can learn more of the ancestry of this interesting family.

Descendant of Isaac Rose of Ramsey County, Minnesota and New Jersey

This cemetery marker is for Mary (Robinette) Rose who married Andrw Jackson Rose, son of Isaac and Mary Rose. Isaac Rose was born 1802 in New Jersey. Four of her sons are listed also: Henry, Charles, Eugene, and Richard.

This is the Newport Cemetery located in Newport, Washington County, Minnesota. Mary has another son buried in the same cemetery. He has his own marker: Walter Rose.

On the backside of the monument shown to the left Cindy included the name of Mary's father, as he was killed in the 1862 Sioux uprising at the Lower Sioux agency, Minnesota. Cindy adds that many were killed there and just buried where they lay. [Photo sent by member Cindy Torfin #282202.]

Will Book L pp. 197-199, petition of Sarah Rose and Nathan Smith, executors of Gorden N. Rose dec'd, late of Town of Onondaga. Will of Gordon N. Rose of Town of Onondaga, to wife Sarah Rose, all property after debts, except personal property is to be kept as far as possible for joint use of my wife and children Stella, Elizabeth, Edwin Burr and Howard Egbert. To wife control and profit of farm of 61 acres, where I now reside, being same described "in the deed of my father and Mother," recorded Book 129 p. 117, the deed of William Rose rec. Book No. 123 p. 121, etc., the deed of Elisha Ford and wife in Deed Book 129 p. 163, for use of children to age of 21 or as long as Sarah remains a widow. Mentions 11 acres, etc. [Did not take all details.] Dated: 17 Nov. 1860. Signed: Gorden N. Rose. Wit.: L. H. Hiscock?, Syracuse; Nathan W. Rose, Syracuse. Proved: 11 Feb. 1861.

Estate of Edwin B. Rose

Will Book T p. 418, petition of Sarah B. Rose, executor. Will of Edwin B. Rose of town of Onondaga, to Trustees of First Methodist Church of Syracuse, \$100, to mother Sarah B. The obituary was provided by Rosemary Ruth Grant Whitney #3149W07, taken from *The Morrow County Sentinel* of January 30, 1902.



Rosemary sent another obituary published the same day, from the Morrow County Independent giving her parentage and stating she was born at Senecaville, Guernsey County, Ohio on October 19, 1836. She died January 25, 1901. She married A. H. Grant of Cardington on November 10, 1859, and they had a daughter Mrs. G. P. Stites of

Cardington, and sons John B. now deceased, A. H. junior of Chicago, Illinois, Samuel P. of Cardington, and William S. of Cleveland.. She sent another obituary published the same day in the Morrow County Independent

Mrs. Ruth Grant.

A woman true and good. What greater eulogy can be written or spoken than is contained in these five words? A wife beyond reproach, an exemplary mother, a devoted sister, a neighborly neighbor, a true friend; ever ready to lend a helping hand; one who had the happy faculty of being able to rejoice in your pleasures and sympathize in your troubles. She was of that disposition that could always find some bright spot in every cloud. She was a member of the Rose family so well known here in former years, who, when young people, made their home the very mecca of pleasure seekers. The past three years have made sad havoc with the Rose family, and from the eastern and western shores of our country to their little home town has come the news of death until there are but four left. Of Mrs. Grant's immediate family there are three sons and one daughter left to mourn this woman good and true. For months she has been an invalid; she whose suffering has been extreme, yet borne with a stoicism that fairly marks her a martyr. She had been a member of the M. E. church since girlhood. Her sufferings ended Saturday morning at 8:30. The funeral services were held at the home on Monday at 2:30 p. m., Rev. Ayers officiating.

William Gray Rose (James² Andrew¹) was born 23 September 1829 Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and died 15 September 1899 Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio. He married 28 March 1858, Martha Emily Parmelee, who was born 5 March 1834 Norton, Summit County, Ohio. [Member of Group N of Rose DNA project.]

Rosa Theo Rose was born May 2, 1919 and died April 13, 2009. She was born in Lakin, Kansas to Frank Evan and Amanda Chesney and married Ira Rose on her birthday, May 2, 1939. They were married 64 years at the time of Ira's death. They had four children. She is survived by Leonard Rose of Toole, Utah,



Nancy Rose Payne of Colorado Springs, Colo. and Norma Derby of Duluth, Ga. Rosa was preceded in death by her husband, her daughter Delores, her parents, four brothers, and a grandson. Mary K. (Spies) Rose died May 30, 2010, in Spokane, Washington. She was born September 5, 1936 in Eugene, Oregon, the daughter of Oliver and Rose (Von Arx) Spies. Mary moved to Spokane in 1948 when her father went to work for the *Spokesman Review*. She is survived by her husband Frank Rose of Spokane, children Martin (Jonna) Mertens of Tacoma, Kevin (Laura) Mertens of Rainier, WA, Mary K. (Dean) Geiselman of Federal Way, WA, Paula (Tom) Crowley of Spokane, Master Sergeant John Mertens currently of Spokane; brothers James Spies of Spokane, Ray Spies of Spokane, Randy (Maura) Spies of Mead, WA; sisters, Rose Marie Hillyard of Spokane, Teresa (Jim) Dempewolf of Modesto, CA; stepson, Michael (Ter-

Bevington—Leo Rose, bachelor, aged 71, died last Monday suddenly after strenuous efforts in mounting a mule. The body was taken in charge by G. F. Bussanmas as none of his relatives live near here. Mr. Rose was born on a farm one mile north of here, and in manhood went to Kansas where he lived until the death of his father. He then came to live on the old homestead. He later sold the farm and opened a soft drink and lunch counter in the old Bevington bank building. He is survived by one brother, Clemm, of Missouri, and three sisters, Mrs. E. Wagner, of Des Moines, Mrs. Magdalena Wiedman of Creston, and Mrs. Mary Weisbrod of Moravia, California. [From the *Madisonian* of June 21, 1928, located at the Licking County, Ohio, library.]

D. J. Rose was 78 years of age; he died Wednesday morning. He was a native of Johnston County, born near Bentonville in 1891. In 1891 he went to Rocky Mount where he lived until his death. He was a leading contractor in Eastern Carolina for 50 years.

He married 1st to Miss Anna Woodall, a sister of Mrs. T. R. Hood, J. H. Woodall and Mrs. Mary W. Myatt of this city. Surviving are two children, Mrs. Boddie Ward of Wilson and Ira Woodall Rose of Rocky Mount.

His second wife was Miss Vara Benton, a sister of Mrs. L. D. Wharton of this city. She survives together with one son, Dillon J. Rose of Rocky Mount.




The family Bible of Timothy Rose, one of the founders of Granville, Ohio, has surfaced and is available for sale. The Bible was printed in 1812. The present owner of the Bible would like to find a direct descendant of the family. Timothy Rose is a known descendant of Robert Rose of Wethersfield and Branford, Connecticut. Deacon Timothy Rose was of the 5th generation of this early family, a son of Justus and Deborah (Barlow) Rose of Granville, Massachusetts. Timothy was one of those chosen to go with Levi Butler and Job Case to Ohio to find a new location of the families. In the latter part of September, 1805, members of the Rose family and others started their removal.

Until their winning streak was broken this fall they had the longest winning streak in volleyball competition. Crayton says he has no idea of which of the various Rose families Mat Russ Rose belongs. However, Crayton does know that in his own group there is some connection to a Russell Rose

III for his grandmother's book of birthday reminders including that name. Crayton is a descendant of Robert Rose of Wethersfield and Branford Connecticut through Daniel^{2, 3, 4}, Russel⁵ Rose. [This is Group A1 of the Rose DNA project.]

ROSE FAMILY DNA PROJECT RESULTS -- To April 6, 2011

GUIDE TO READING THIS TABLE

Since the beginning of our Rose Project in 2001, we have seen the markers available to be tested progressively grow from the original 12, now to 67. Each step forward has been a refinement, providing a better confidence level in results, and often allowing us to define certain lines or subgroups from within larger original Rose families. Due to space limitations and readability, we now provide 37 in this table, although all conclusions made are on the basis of all markers tested. We sincerely hope this provides you with more information and a better perspective of the results.

This table is divided into family groups which are indicated to be paternally related by their Y-DNA results thus far. Each group is identified by a 1-3 character Alpha-Numeric symbol. These include Groups A to Z, AA to NN, A1, CX, and others. All participants within each Group are estimated to share a common All-Male Line Ancestor within a Genealogical time frame, or since the surname may have become meaningful. In the identification each group, when a numeral follows a letter, it identifies either a specific branch (Subgroup) within the same family (see K1, T2), or a Group estimated to be related further back in time, usually before Emigration (see A1, K2, L1). When an X or Y follows a letter, it indicates a Non-Paternal relationship with the above group, which is noted in the title line. No other relationships in a meaningful time frame appear likely between the separate groups. A few of the groups appear out of order due to space. Kit numbers which appear in **bold** indicate new results since last printing. The column on the far right, labeled "PROB%", indicates the statistical probability (confidence level) that this sample belongs to their respective family group or subgroup. The sample within each group is estimated to be most representative of the original pattern, appears in **bold**, and all others in the group are measured against his results.

estimated to most representative of the original parent at that point. All others in one group are measured against its results.

The DYS #'s refer to specific locations within the Y-Chromosome. The numeric value under each is the number of Short Tandem Repeats in the sample at that location. These "STR's" are repeated nucleotide sequences, or spacing, as on a ladder, which the DNA physically resembles. Variations in these numbers (*shown in bold italics*) are slight mutations from the original pattern. The number of mutations occurring between samples can often be indicative of the distance of the relationship, or in extremes, an independent family Group. However the specific markers (Loci) involved, and other factors must be taken into consideration. Many markers mutate much faster than others. Great advances have been made in the study of these markers and their individual characteristics in recent years. These allow us to interpret the results much more easily, and with greater accuracy. It must also be noted that DNA is one of many tools at a Genealogists disposal, although a powerful one. It is essential to use it within the context of more traditional research methods, and the paper trail produced by it.
