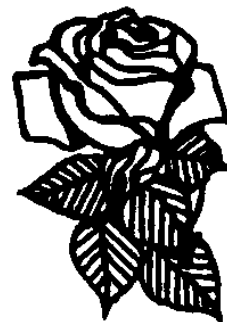

Lifus Milo Rose

This obituary was sent by Peggy Arnsman, name and date of newspaper unknown. See a family photo on the front page of the December 2009 RFB issue.]

How feeble are words to carry consolation to the hearts of this household in the death of the devoted husband and father. His life was like a glorious spirit of light that flitted in and out like a gleam of sunshine.

Lifus Milo Rose was the son of Seabird and Lucinda Shelton Rose, and was the last remaining member of this family. He was born and reared in Gallia, Ohio, and spent a good part of his life in that vicinity. He moved from Oak Hill to Jackson seventeen years ago. He was a blacksmith by trade and retired several years ago.

In early life he became a member of the Gallia Baptist church, where he attended Sunday

School and church services with his parents, brothers and sisters. On March 8, 1902, he was united in marriage to Rose Hutchins at Peniel, Ohio. To this union was born three sons and four daughters. Six of the children are here today with their mother to mourn the loss of a kind and loving husband and father. Donovan, a son and a promising young lad, preceded his father in death on February 28, 1928.

Lifus Rose was born in Gallia, Ohio, April 30, 1874, and passed away at Jackson, Ohio, Friday morning, September 11, 1953, at the age of 79 years, 4 months and 12 days. He was in his usual fair health until stricken. He leaves to mourn his loss his devoted wife and the following children: Marie of Chillicothe, Ohio; Dottie of Cincinnati, Ohio; Paul, Lucinda, David and Helen, all of Jackson, and eleven grandchildren and one great grandchild, to all of whom, he was extremely devoted. He also leaves a host of other relatives and friends.

Vincent Weyant Rose, son of Reuben Carter³ Rose, David² Rose, Israel¹ Rose of Orange County, New York. Vincent was born 19 February 1819 and died 18 August 1879. He is buried in the United Presbyterian Church Cemetery in Dover, Wisconsin.

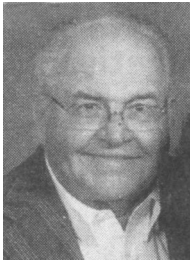
Vincent is listed in the 1850 Census of Racine County, Wisconsin; Elizabeth C. age 31 with him and some children.

Mr. S. G. Rose [Stephen Gilbert Rose] of Warren township [Lucas County, Iowa] died at noon on Friday, in the 63rd year of his age. He had been ill for several weeks. He was buried on Monday and the followers to his resting place was one of the largest ever seen in the township. "Squire Rose was a good man, and his death will be mourned by all who know him." 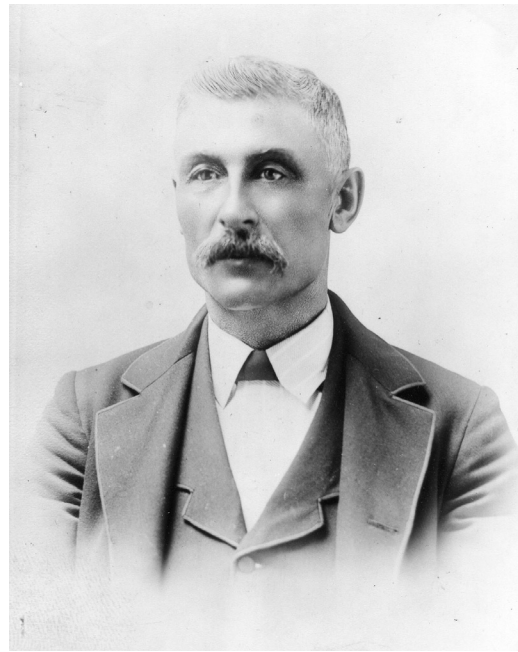

Letter: Eglon, Ky. 22 July 1929 from Robert Rose to Mr. Earl D. Church, says he served under "Curnal Medcalf," Capt. Jess Berry, was on furlough when war ceased and has no discharge or got it misplaced.

Survivor's Pension: Jackson Co., Ky. 14 June 1929, Robert Rose, born about 10 April 1845 Goochland, Ky., age 84, enlisted Lexington, Ky., discharged about 1864, he also served in Civil War, 5' 7", white complexion, blue eyes, light hair, since service resided at Eglon, Ky., farming, wholly incapacitated, about blind and deaf, etc. Signed by x mark. Wit.: John S. Ballard, Robert Maupin. N.P. was J. F. Rose, Eglon, Ky.

Declaration: Jackson Co., Ky. 19 Apr. 1895, Robert Rose, aged 46, resident of Monill (Morrill?), co. of Jackson, Ky., Co. B 7th Reg. Ky. Cav. commanded by Metcalf, discharged at Cynthiana, Ky. by furlough discharge by reason of mumps and fever, age 46, 5' 9", fair complexion, light hair, blue eyes, etc. Signed by x mark. PO is Monill (Morrill?), Ky.

Form: 16 Aug. 1929, name: Robertson Rose (note says not found as Robert Rose), Co. B 7th Reg. Ky. Vol. Cav., also served same regiment, age 18, enrolled 15 July 1862, deserted 30 Aug. 1862, was private.

Letter: 14 Sept. 1929 from Commissioner to Mr. John J. O'Brien, McGill Bldg., Washington, D.C., rejected on ground that claimant was not honorably discharged, having enlisted 15 July 1862, Troop B, etc., from which he deserted Aug. 30, 1862, as shown by a report from the records of the War Department.

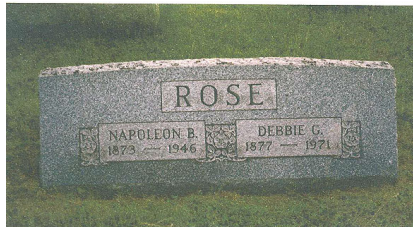

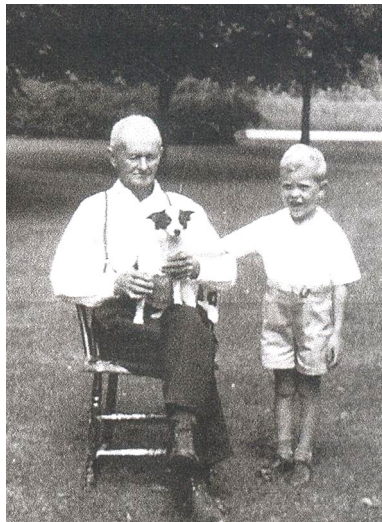

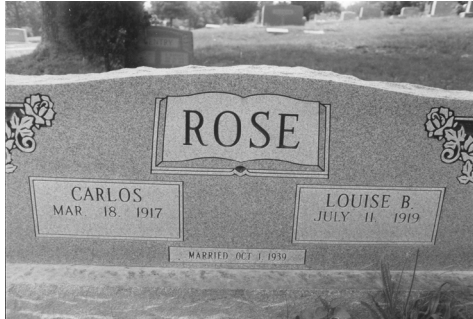

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION on obituary page 5708 of March 2012 *Rose Family Bulletin*. Member Norman Everett Rose #3206R09 tells us that he was surprised to see this obituary sent by Thomas M. Rose. It is of his mother, who however is Isabel Reynolds Rose (not Isabel Rose Reynolds). She was born Marian Isabel Reynolds and was the daughter of Phernie Bartlett of Newcastle, England and Junius Edward Reynolds of Richmond, Virginia. She was the widow of Milton Carlisle Rose, Sr. The sons mentioned are Rose, not Reynolds.

Carlos Rose family of Webster County, Kentucky

The photo was provided by Marilyn Parsons. She tells us it was taken in 1984 in Webster County, Kentucky in a cemetery on Hwy. 630,



about 4 miles south of Dixon towards Madisonville. We did a bit of searching on the Internet - Carlos is likely the one listed in the 1920 Census of Taylor County, Kentucky with Eugene H. Rose (b. ca 1877) and his wife Susan, and some other children. In 1930 he is there shown as E. Allen Rose. In the 1900 Census of Adair County,

Kentucky Eugene Rose is listed as born April 1876, Susan as May 1880. In the 1880 Census of Adair County there is a John W. Rose 38 b. Va., both parents born Virginia, Mary E. 34, and with them Allen Rose age 6. These are possibly all the same family. Anyone tracing them?

Harold Rose #2228R96, descendant of John Rose of Wolfe County, Kentucky, tells us that he and his wife Dorothy visited the grave of Captain Lewis Rose over the years. Lewis is buried at Ft. Harrold, Kentucky in a small park with a rebuilt colonial fort. Lewis was a son of Gottlieb Rose of Germany. Lewis fought in the Revolutionary War and was thought killed by Indians until he suddenly returned home!



Cindy Dyer Nelson is a long-time researcher of the family of Richard and Sarah (Harrell) Rose of Robertson and Stewart Counties, Tennessee and Callaway County, Missouri. Cindy descends from Richard¹, Alexander², Thomas Alexander³ Rose born 22 March 1846 who married Synthia Caroline Knott. This family falls into Group A-1 of the Rose Family Association Y-DNA project. Cindy is pictured above with her husband Randy Nelson.

Charter member Floyd Legan Jr. told us sometime ago that the Rose Cemetery in Putnam County, Missouri (in which Benjamin Rose is buried) was expanded. It was originally approximately 400 acres. The Cemetery's first occupants were two of the Rose family Blacks and then one of the Family members were interred there and continued to fill up the available plots. It is well maintained: fenced and has a lawn. Floyd's cousin is one of the cemetery trustees.

GUIDE TO READING THIS TABLE

Since the beginning of our Rose Project in 2001, we have seen the markers available to be tested progressively grow from the original 12, now to 111. Each step forward has been a refinement, providing a better confidence level in results, and often allowing us to define certain lines or subgroups from within larger original Rose families. Due to space limitations and readability, we now provide 37 in this table, although all conclusions made are on the basis of all markers tested. We sincerely hope this provides you with more information and a better perspective of the results.

This table is divided into family groups which are indicated to be paternally related by their Y-DNA results thus far. Each group is identified by a 1-3 character Alpha-Numeric symbol. These include Groups A to Z, AA to NN, AI, CX, and others. All participants within each Group are estimated to share a common All-Male Line Ancestor within a Genealogical time frame, or since the surname may have become meaningful. In the Identification each group, when a numeral follows a letter, it identifies either a specific branch (Subgroup) within the same family (see K1, T2), or a Group estimated to be related further back in time, usually before Emigration (see A1, K2, L1). When an X or Y follows a letter, it indicates a Non-Paternal relationship with the above group, which is noted in the title line. No other relationships in a meaningful time frame appear likely between the separate groups. Kit numbers which appear in **bold** indicate new results since the last printing.

The column on the far right, labeled "PROB%", indicates the statistical probability (confidence level) that this sample belongs to their respective family group or subgroup. The sample within each group estimated to be most representative of the original pattern appears in **bold print**. All others in the group are measured against his results.

The DYS #'s refer to specific locations within the Y-Chromosome. The numeric value under each is the number of Short Tandem Repeats in the sample at that location. These "STR"s are repeated nucleotide sequences, or spacing, as on a ladder, which the DNA physically resembles. Variations in these numbers (*strown in bold italics*) are slight mutations from the original pattern. The number of mutations occurring between samples can often be indicative of the distance of the relationship, or in extremes, an independent family Group. However the specific markers (Loc) involved, and other factors must be taken into consideration. Many markers mutate much faster than others. Great advances have been made in the study of these markers and their individual characteristics in recent years. These allow us to interpret the results much more easily, and with greater accuracy. It must also be noted that DNA is one of many tools at a Genealogists disposal, although a powerful one. It is essential to use it within the context of more traditional research methods and the paper trail produced by it.
